Of Sodomites, Effeminates, Hermaphrodites, and Androgynes

This book is composed of two parts. The first consists of four chapters treating basic questions in the historical study of sex and gender. Each begins with the ancient world and moves through the early middle ages. Chapter one emphasizes that all centuries had a varied language of sex. In showing there was no single understanding of gender and power relationships, the second chapter argues that the story of gender should encompass more than the history of power. Of special interest is the means by which "sex" was put into words, passed from inarticulateness to articulateness. Central is the vocabulary of the penitentials and canon law, studied in chapter three. This leads in the following chapter to examination of the question of the forms of sexual imagination that existed in the early middle ages. Here and elsewhere, the argument is illustrated by examination of the literature, art, and sculpture of the period.

Part two turns to Peter Damian, especially his Epistle 31, the so-called Book of Gomorrah. Chapter by chapter, the principle themes of this work are analyzed, along with such questions as whether Damian represents the onset of "the persecuting society." The chapters study Damian's understanding of nature and sins against nature. Chapter eight, on *luxuria*, contains numerous illustrations from Romanesque sculpture, and the final chapter explores Damian's sense of the relation between demonic incitement, lust, free will, and effeminacy, and his notion that sodomy might be "situational."
