The Pontifical Institute's Summer School continues this year with an expanded roster of courses. The programme is taught by M. Michèle Mulchahey, Leonard E. Boyle Professor of Manuscript Studies at the Pontifical Institute of Mediaeval Studies, and by Dr Greti Dinkova-Bruun, Associate Fellow of the Institute. All courses are held in the Palaeography Room of the PIMS Library.

Summer School in Latin Palaeography 1–25 June 2010

A four-week intensive introduction to mediaeval handwriting in the Latin West from the late Roman period until the dawn of print, this course is designed for those who wish to acquire the skills that will enable them to work with unpublished Latin manuscript materials from the mediaeval period, whether as researchers or as librarians and collectors.

Reading knowledge of Latin is essential and will be assumed.
