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The studies contained in this volume were originally presented at a conference held at the University of Calgary in 1974. They deal with three main issues of contemporary interest on which Aquinas' views are still considered illuminating: the nature and destiny of man; the nature of his relationship to fellow men; and the nature of his relationship to God. The style of philosophizing on these matters has changed since the time of Aquinas, and we have our own, if diverse, approaches to these issues. Yet surprisingly enough, the substance of Aquinas' thought and the spirit of his approach remain an important and an indispensable element in any serious appraisal of man's secular and religious activities.

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
